"It is a ghost!" When the disciples see Jesus walking on the lake they are terrified. They think that the eerie figure coming towards them must be from another kind of existence. Why wouldn't they think that? The boat is battling heavy seas in the predawn darkness; what earthly person could be out there WALKING on the water? Jesus understands their fears and calms them with the simplest of words: "Courage! It is I."

There is another 'ghost' story in the gospels. Luke 24: 37 records the incredulity of the disciples after the resurrection. They have gathered in Jerusalem (behind closed doors) when Jesus suddenly stands among them. Again, in fear, they think they are seeing a ghost. Again, Jesus reassures them that He is truly a physical reality. "Look... touch me... See for yourselves. It is I indeed. A ghost has no flesh and bones as you can see I have."

The message is clear. Jesus is not a creature of mist and mirage. He took our nature and was wholly present, in the flesh, in our world. The first disciples had the evidence of their eyes. We look to the Scriptures and to the truths of our Creed. In a sublime way Jesus is consubstantial with the Father; equally He was "incarnate from the Virgin Mary and made man." It is this man who could walk on water — and rise from the dead.




