

# **Reflection for Toda**

Happy Gaudete Sunday! Today, the third Sunday in Advent, we light the pink candle of the Advent Wreath and rejoice because our salvation is near. 'Gaudete' is a Latin word that means "reioice." and it comes from the entrance antiphon for Sunday's Mass.

We're reminded that Advent is a season of joy because our salvation is already at hand. It's all about celebrating the coming of Christ and his presence in our lives.

The first reading from Isaiah foreshadows the coming of the Messiah, who will bring good news to the poor, free the oppressed, and save his people. It's an inspiring message that Jesus himself used as his mission and identity statement.

The second reading encourages us to take a spiritual 'health check' and reflect on whether we're rejoicing, praying, and giving thanks. It's a great opportunity to prepare for the sacrament of reconciliation.

In today's Gospel, John the Baptist is questioned by the Jewish authorities about his identity and the meaning of his baptisms. John explains that he's not the Messiah, Elijah, or the Prophet. Instead, he announces that the saviour they seek is already among them but yet unrecognised. John's response highlights an important Advent theme: Jesus has already come into the world as our saviour.

During Advent, we pray that we will be able to recognise his presence in our midst and continue to be watchful as we anticipate his return. So, let's rejoice, pray, and give thanks as we prepare for the coming of Christ during this Advent season. May God bless us all!
