

Reflection for Today

Today's readings bring us a message of hope and love. The idea of universal salvation may have caused disagreement in the past, but it reminds us that every person has value and worth. It's important to remember that salvation is not automatic but rather a gift from a power greater than ourselves. This power is the love of God, working through our lives in Christ Jesus. We are all sinners, but through our faith and trust in God's love, we can be saved.

The Prophet Isaiah speaks of God's salvation for all who honour His name and become His servants. This includes people of all religions and backgrounds. It's a wonderful thing to live in a time where we can believe that everyone has the potential to be saved. We are encouraged to have respect for all religious systems and to appreciate those who seek truth in any form.

In the Gospel, we see Jesus moved by the faith of a woman who was not "of the chosen people". This challenges us to have faith like hers and to appreciate the faith of others, even those who don't share our own beliefs. We may even encounter people who trust more in God than we do, despite not having an obvious faith. This is a reminder of the power of faith and the love of God.

Let us reflect on these readings and allow our faith to grow. May we learn to love and respect others, no matter their background or beliefs. And may we find ways to share our own faith so that others can experience the incredible power of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

To ensure our Parish runs smoothly and efficiently we require more volunteers, in all communities.


