Reflection for Today

"Desperation with a Drop of Faith"

Today's readings remind us that in desperate situations even a drop of faith in Our Lord is enough to make the outcome exceed our expectations. Jesus gave hope where there seemed to be no human cause for it. He spoke words of hope to the woman, "Take heart, daughter!" and to awaken the spark of faith in her, he said, "Your faith has made you well!"

Today's Gospel reports two stories of healing. One story tells us about a father's great love for his dying daughter. The other story tells us about a desperate woman who risks much as she seeks healing from Jesus. In each story, the request for healing is itself a courageous act of faith, and yet very different circumstances are represented by the lives of each suffering person.

The contrasts between Jairus and the woman with the hemorrhage are simple and illuminating. One is a man, and the other is a woman. One is a public official, an important person in the community, and the other is a woman who has lost everything to find a cure to a condition that separated her from the community. One approaches Jesus publicly, and the other approaches Jesus secretly. Yet in each case, faith leads them to seek out Jesus in their time of need. The truth is that people in desperate or helpless circumstances were not disappointed when they sought Jesus out. Thus, the way we approach the Lord Jesus with expectant faith or with skeptical doubt is our reflection for today.

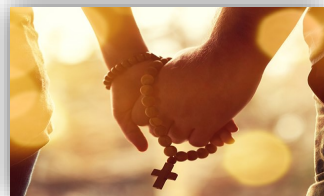
