Reflection for Today

"There is nothing new under the sun" (Ecclesiastes 1:9). The things that happened to Jesus in the Gospel, can sometimes be applied to each one of us today. We are living in a society where material things seem to have a big influence on the mind of people, especially the younger generation. It seems harder for us to keep and live our faith, sometimes even within the family context. Many people from Nazareth, the hometown of Jesus, did not accept him as a prophet because they "knew" Jesus and the family. They also "knew" that this "son of the carpenter" could not be the promised Messiah, who would come from Bethlehem as a descendant of David's royal family. Today's Scriptures challenge us to take courage and be strong when we face those difficult moments in our lives. Very often our friends, families, or childhood companions fail to listen to us and refuse to accept the words of grace, love, and encouragement that we offer to them. They are so familiar with us that they are unable to see us as God's appointed instruments. However, we must remember that at our Baptism we are called to be prophets like Jesus and sharing the prophetic mission of Jesus. As prophets, it is our task to "speak the truth in love" and to oppose the evils in our society without condoning or encouraging sinful behavior, even in our dear ones. It is not an easy task to do. "Do not be afraid" Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit to be with us and help us. The question is "Do we open ourselves to receive and allow the Holy Spirit to work within us?"

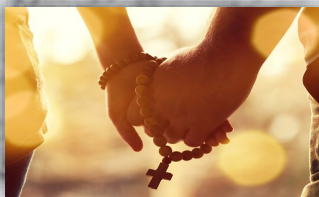

Kainga Pasifika hope to provide many services for the Pacific community. One service we will be providing is our driving school. Both Ave Faka'osi and Malia Onesi have gained their Instructors License, so are now able to help learner drivers with translating the Road Code and to teach how to be a good driver. We received fantastic news last week that we have been funded a Drivers Instructors car, so it will not be long before this service starts.

As we are a charity, we rely on funding, so we are very fortunate to have a wonderful Business leader in Malcolm Byford and a great team of BOT, who are dedicated in making this venture work.
