Items from November Agenda to be held over until 2021 -

- Discussion on types of services that can be held at Aubert Centre: Liam Greer has visited Aubert Centre to look at what is needed to upgrade facilities. Brian Kelly also present. Tevita who is setting up Kainga Pacifica Services which works to eliminate domestic violence in families, has been accorded stand-alone charitable trust status. They are looking at forming as partnership with Catholic Parish of Hastings and to rent the centre. Arrangements for an agreement to lease and other paperwork have started to give impetus for the refurbishment, modification and use of the Aubert Mission Centre. Several ideas for use of centre put forward, but this would depend on what space the lessee has available. Liam Greer has offered his help. Finance of the refurbishment will take time. We need to promote Tevita throughout CPH. People of Flaxmere and CPH need to kept up with what is happening. Look at ways to contact those parishioners in Flaxmere – Parish Roll or through school newsletter.
- Ideas for celebration of Suzanne Aubert's Beatification:
  Sisters of Compassion and Archbishop Dew working towards announcement of Suzanne Aubert's Beatification. It was important that Maori people be approached to see what they think should happen. Suzanne Aubert celebrations involve more than our parish the region extends beyond the PPC. With COVID-19 cancelling any Pilgrimages overseas, the thought that a Pilgrimage, retracing sacred places in the footsteps of Suzanne Aubert could be held in Hawkes Bay.

 Catholic Parish of Hastings Annual Meeting: General discussion held as to what form this meeting should take. Parishioners like to have time to discuss matters and ask question. Shorter reports Fr Marcus to speak to Brian Kelly to see when financial report will be available. Two dates suggested – 27<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> March after 8 am Mass, followed by a cup of tea then meeting. Fr Marcus to organise.
