Structure:

- For the needs of the church
- Priest to introduce prayers of intercession
- Start prayers with 'that...' or 'for...' create intentions from the theme of the Sunday readings, and make them brief and to the point.
- Include prayer for RCIA candidates from Rite of Election till Easter Sunday
- Parish office to let you know of any weddings, baptisms and deaths for inclusion in the prayers. (deceased mentioned last)
- No need to mention the Pope, Bishop, Priests or Thanksgiving as this prayer is in the Eucharistic prayer.

Your contribution would be appreciated in the parish office by Wednesday morning, preferably via email. ***(4<sup>th</sup> Sunday POF need to be into the office the week before, due to Multi-Cultural Mass having to get prayers to people, so that they can be translated into different languages)***

Please inform the office if you cannot do your rostered month or for some reason cannot do a Sunday.
